

CHARTER Union of Belarusian Jewish Associations and Communities

(UBJOC)

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1. Union of Belarusian Jewish Public Associations and Communities (hereinafter referred to as UBJOC) is a voluntary association of Jewish public associations of a national, cultural, educational and charitable nature.

1.2. Name of the Union in Russian:

full - Union of Belarusian Jewish Public Associations and Communities.

abbreviated - UBJOC in Belarusian:

full - Union of Belarusian Jewish Public Associations and Communities (hereinafter referred to as UBJOC)

1.3. UBJOC operates on the territory of the Republic of Belarus.

1.4. UBJOC carries out its activities in accordance with

The Constitution of the Republic of Belarus, the Law of the Republic of Belarus "On Public Associations", other acts of the legislation of the Republic of Belarus and this Charter.

1.5. UBJOC can join international (non-governmental) organizations, maintain direct international contacts and communications, conclude relevant agreements, and also participate in the implementation of activities that do not contradict the legislation and international obligations of the Republic of Belarus.

1.6. UBJOC operates on the basis of self-financing and self-sufficiency, is a legal entity, has a seal, stamps, its own symbols registered in the prescribed manner, settlement and currency accounts in banks of the Republic of Belarus.

1.7. Office work in UBJOC is carried out in accordance with the established procedure. Documentation, which is determined by law, is submitted to the relevant institutions of the National Archival Fund at the location of the legal entity.

2. GOALS, OBJECTIVES, SUBJECT AND METHODS OF ACTIVITY

2. 1. The objectives of UBJOC are:

- revival and consolidation of Jews in the Republic of Belarus, both national and cultural community;

- protection of the honor and national dignity of members of public associations that are part of UBJOC;

- charity.

2.2. The tasks of UBJOC are:

- coordinating the efforts of individual organizations and citizens in the field of promoting Jewish education for members of public associations that are part of UBJOC, and members of their families, the study of national, spiritual and cultural values; representing the interests of Jewish public organizations that are members of UBJOC in state authorities and administration;

- establishing direct links with public organizations of the State of Israel and other countries;

- interaction with Jewish organizations of other countries on the issues of cultural and scientific exchanges, the study of national traditions, etc.;

- assistance in the creation of new Jewish public organizations in the Republic of Belarus.

2.3. The subject of activity of UBJOC is the work on the revival and consolidation of the Jews in the Republic of Belarus, the promotion of the development of national Jewish culture and traditions.

2.4. To achieve its goals and objectives, UBJOC uses the following methods:

- promotion of the activities of UBJOC through the media and the holding of traditional folk Jewish holidays and charity events;

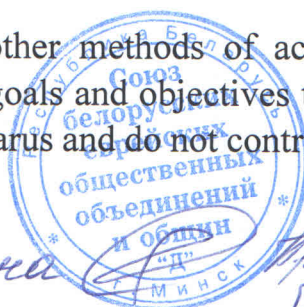
- organization of exhibitions, seminars, debates, meetings, round tables, conferences and other events related to the development of Jewish culture;

- cooperation with international organizations and individual citizens in accordance with the statutory goals and objectives; implementation of activities related to the receipt and distribution of humanitarian aid among the members of UBJOC and the organization of the rehabilitation of children abroad;

- Establishment of weekend schools.

2.5. In accordance with the legislation, UBJOC establishes its own mass media, carries out publishing and other activities aimed at achieving the statutory goals and objectives.

UBJOC uses in its daily life other methods of activity that contribute to the implementation of the statutory goals and objectives that are not prohibited by the legislation of the Republic of Belarus and do not contradict its international treaties.

3. ELECTION BODIES OF UBJOC

3.1. The supreme body of UBJOC is the Congress, whose meetings are held once every three years. An Extraordinary Congress is held by decision of the Coordinating Council (hereinafter referred to as the CC), at the request of at least one third of the members of UBJOC or the Audit Commission.

The agenda, place and date of the Congress, the procedure for electing delegates and the quota of representation for the Congress is determined by the Constitutional Court and not later than a month in advance is reported to the members of UBJOC. The congress is competent if at least two thirds of the elected delegates participate in its work. Decisions are taken by a simple majority vote of the Congress delegates present. The form of voting is established by the Congress.

Congress:

- defines the main directions of activity of UBJOC;
- approves the name and adopts the Charter, makes changes and (or) additions to it; solves the most important issues of activity, determines the next and long-term tasks;
- elects an advisory body - the Board consisting of the Chairman, Vice-Chairmen, members of the Board for a period of 3 years; elects the governing body - the Coordinating Council for a period of 3 years;
- elects the Audit Commission for a period of 3 years;
- approves the reports of the CC, the Management Board, the Audit Commission;
- makes a decision to terminate the activities of UBJOC; considers complaints from members of UBJOC against decisions of the elected bodies of the SBE000.

The congress may take into consideration any other issue of the statutory activities of UBJOC.

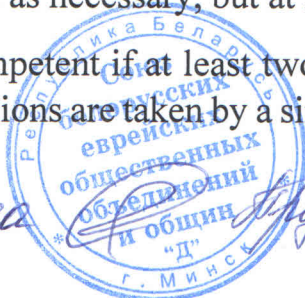
3.2 The Coordinating Council (hereinafter referred to as the CC) is the governing body of UBJOC. The Constitutional Court directs the activities of UBJOC between congresses.

Members of the CC are representatives elected by the Congress from public organizations - members of UBJOC. If necessary, members of UBJOC are authorized to replace their representatives in the CC during the period between congresses.

Meetings of the CC are held as necessary, but at least once every three months.

Meetings of the CC are competent if at least two thirds of the members of the CC participate in its work. Decisions are taken by a simple majority vote of the members

of the CC present. In case of equality of votes, the decision for which the Chairman of UBJOC voted is taken.

The CC ex officio includes the Chairman of UBJOC and members of the Board. The Chairman of the Board is also the head of UBJOC.

3.3. Coordination Council:

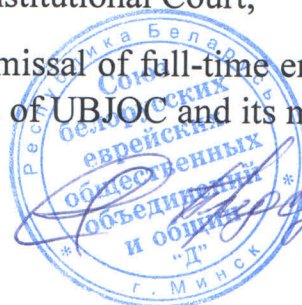
- determines the forms, methods and ways of implementing the decisions of the congresses, organizes their implementation; makes changes and (or) additions to the Charter related to changes in legislation, as well as related to changes in the legal address;
- Carries out admission and expulsion from members of UBJOC, keeps records of them;
- listens to the reports and reports of the heads of the organizations of the members of UBJOC;
- prepares materials for meetings of congresses;
- ensures the coordination of the activities of the members of UBJOC;
- ensures the development of the material base of UBJOC;
- organizing publishing and other activities aimed at solving statutory tasks;
- manages the property and funds of UBJOC within the limits determined by the Congress of UBJOC;
- approves sketches of the seal, stamp, forms and symbols;
- decides on the quotas of members of UBJOC at congresses;
- if necessary, creates the Board of Trustees of UBJOC and approves the regulation on it;
- considers other issues of statutory activities within its competence.

3.4. Chairman of UBJOC (Chairman of the Board) has all the rights and powers of the head of a legal entity.

Chairman of UBJOC is elected at the Congress for a term of three years. Chairman of UBJOC:

- manages the activities of the CC and the Board; is the manager of loans within the amounts determined by the Constitutional Court;
- Carries out the hiring and dismissal of full-time employees; - without a power of attorney represents the interests of UBJOC and its members in state authorities and

administration, in relations with enterprises, organizations and institutions, public associations of citizens;

- holds meetings of the CC and the Board and ensures the implementation of their decisions;

- determines the functional duties of the members of the Management Board; - appoints and determines the functional duties of the Directorate and the General Director; performs other functions ex officio within its competence.

Decisions of Chairman of UBJOC may be appealed to the Congress. 3.5. The Board is an advisory body of UBJOC. Members of the Board are elected at the Congress of UBJOC. Decisions of the Board are recommendatory in nature, adopted by a simple majority and formalized by a protocol. In case of equality of votes, a decision is made, for which Chairman of UBJOC voted.

The Board is convened at the initiative of Chairman of UBJOC or at least half of its members.

3.6. The Audit Commission of UBJOC (hereinafter referred to as the AC) is a control and auditing body that carries out an internal audit of the financial and economic activities of UBJOC, as well as internal control over the compliance of the activities of UBJOC with legislation and the charter.

The RK is elected by the Congress of UBJOC for a period of 3 years.

Audit Commission of UBJOC:

- controls the observance by the elected bodies and members of UBJOC of the current legislation, this Charter;

- checks the state of accounting and reporting, financial and economic activities of UBJOC and legal entities created by it, whose activities are aimed at achieving the statutory goals and objectives;

- checks the accounting of documents and the organization of office work in UBJOC, the timing of consideration and the validity of responses to complaints, letters and statements from citizens.

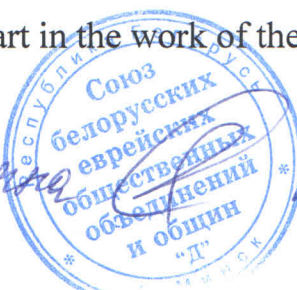
Meetings, inspections and revisions of the SC are held as necessary, but at least once a year. The work of the SC is managed by the Chairman of the SC, elected by its members from among its members.

Members of the AC cannot be elected to other elected bodies of UBJOC, hold positions of managers and chief specialists in legal entities created by UBJOC.

Members of the AC may take part in the work of the elected bodies of UBJOC with the right of an advisory vote.

In its work, the AC is accountable to the Congress of UBJOC.

3.7. The executive body of UBJOC is the Directorate appointed by Chairman of UBJOC and headed by the General Director.

3.8. Decisions of all elected bodies are documented in protocols.

3.9. Decisions of the elected bodies of UBJOC may be appealed to the Congress.

4. MEMBERS OF THE UNION, THEIR RIGHTS AND DUTIES

4.1. Members of UBJOC can be Jewish public organizations operating in the Republic of Belarus, recognizing the Charter of UBJOC and supporting its goals, objectives and subject of activity.

4.2. To become a member of UBJOC, an organization submits an Application to the Coordinating Council, which makes a decision within a month from the date of submission of the application.

4.3. Membership in UBJOC is terminated due to the liquidation of the organization or the EXIT from it.

4.4. An organization is considered to have withdrawn from UBJOC after submitting an application for a decision to withdraw from UBJOC and the relevant decision of the CC.

4.5. The decision to refuse admission or exclusion from UBJOC can be appealed to the Congress of UBJOC.

4.6. A member of UBJOC has the right to:

- to delegate their representatives to the Congress of the UNBEOOOO in accordance with the quotas established by the Constitutional Court;

- participate in all events held by UBJOC;

- submit proposals for consideration by elected bodies on issues within the scope of their activities; participate in the elections of the governing and control and auditing bodies of UBJOC, nominate candidates and delegate their representatives to the elected bodies of UBJOC;

- to receive any information about their activities from the elected bodies of UBJOC;

- send materials for publication in print media and individual publications of UBJOC;

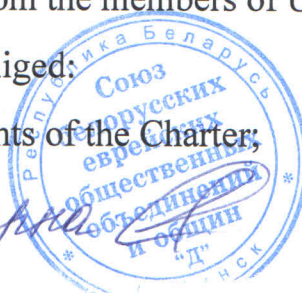
- apply to the elected bodies of UBJOC for the protection of their rights and legitimate interests; free exit from the members of UBJOC.

4.7. a member of UBJOC is obliged:

- to comply with the requirements of the Charter;

- To increase the authority of UBJOC, to actively participate in the implementation of its goals and objectives, to implement the decisions adopted by its elected bodies;

4.8. Exclusion from members of UBJOC is carried out in the following cases:

- violations of the Charter of UBJOC;
- systematic evasion from participation in the work of UBJOC;

Other measures of responsibility determined by the decision of the Constitutional Court may be applied to the members of UBJOC.

4.9. Members of UBJOC have the right to apply with appeals (proposals, applications, complaints) to the Audit Commission or the Congress in case of violations of the law and the charter of UBJOC, committed by the elected bodies of UBJOC.

5. REGULATION OF MEMBERS

5.1. Registration of members of UBJOC is carried out by the CC by maintaining a general list of members.

5.2. Every year, not later than January 31, the CC is updating the list of members in order to identify retired members. After identifying the retired members, the CC within 30 days decides on the exclusion of these organizations from among the members of UBJOC.

5.3. After the decision of the CC on the exclusion, a new list of members is drawn up, which is approved by Chairman of UBJOC.

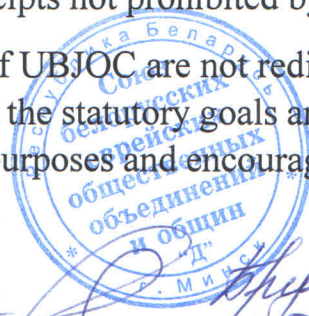
6. FUNDS AND PROPERTY.

6.1. UBJOC may own any property necessary for the material support of the activities provided for by the Charter, with the exception of objects that, according to the Law, can only be owned by the state.

6.2. UBJOC funds are formed from:

- entrance and membership fees;
- voluntary contributions and donations from citizens, enterprises, institutions of Belarus and other states;
- proceeds from holding exhibitions, charitable cultural events and other events not prohibited by law; - other receipts not prohibited by law.

6.3. The funds and property of UBJOC are not redistributed among the members of UBJOC and are used to fulfill the statutory goals and objectives. It is allowed to use UBJOC funds for charitable purposes and encourage participants in the activities of UBJOC.

7. TERMINATION OF ACTIVITIES.

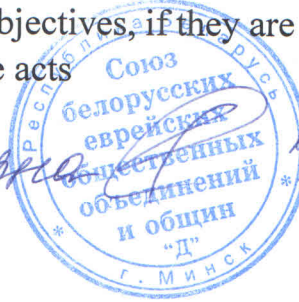
7.1. Termination of the activities of UBJOC is carried out by reorganization or liquidation.

7.2. UBJOC can be liquidated by a decision voted for by more than two thirds of its members, the Supreme Court of the Republic of Belarus.

7.3. The funds and property remaining after the satisfaction of claims are used for the liquidation statutory goals and objectives, if they are not subject to circulation in state revenue in accordance with the acts
